Using tongue twisters can help in improving your “**diction**”, or **the ability to speak clearly so you can be understood**. A tongue twister is a sentence or phrase that is difficult to articulate clearly and quickly. Here is an example:

“Peter Piper picked a peck of pickled peppers.”
