

Attendance Policy 5201

I. PURPOSE

Athlos Academy believes in the direct correlation between student achievement and regular school attendance. The purpose of this policy is to encourage regular attendance in order to foster life-long traits of focus, self-control, and leadership within the students. It is a shared responsibility of students, parent/guardians, teachers, and school administration to ensure that a student attends school regularly. This policy applies only to students who participate at least in part at a traditional brick and mortar school setting. For students attending school via distance learning full-time, see Policy 5303.

II. POLICY

A. Attendance:

- 1. Utah's Compulsory Attendance Laws state that all school age children, past the age of 6 and not yet 18 years old, must attend school and arrive on time unless there is a valid and legitimate excuse.
 - a. Students are expected to attend all of their classes on time and make up any missing work in the event of an absence;
 - b. Parent/guardian(s) are expected to ensure their student is attending school and notify the school in the event of an unavoidable absence;
 - c. Teachers will take daily attendance, provide assignments to students upon their request (only in instances of excused absences), and enforce attendance policies for all of their students;
 - d. The school administration will maintain accurate attendance records, provide a responsible person to approve student check-outs, and regularly inform the parent/guardian(s) of the student's attendance and notify them of attendance issues as soon as one is identified; and
 - e. For purposes of pupil accounting, continuing enrollment status shall be assigned to all students in compliance with Utah Admin R277-419; this provision only applies to Athlos Academy students taking online courses for reasons outlined in R277-419.

B. Excused Absence:

1. "Excused Absence" means an absence that is verified by the student's parent/guardian for one of the following explanations:

- a. an illness, which may be either mental or physical (excessive illness requires medical verification);
- b. serious illness in the student's immediate family;
- c. a family death;
- d. an approved school activity;
- e. religious instruction (not to exceed 3 hours per week), or a religious holiday;
- f. extreme family emergency;
- g. medical appointments (that cannot be scheduled outside of school hours);
- h. an absence permitted by a school-aged child's:
 - i. individualized educational program; or
 - ii. Section 504 accommodation plan
- i. an absence permitted in accordance with Subsection 53G-6-803(5)

C. Unexcused Absence:

- 1. Any absence for a reason other than a reason described in Subsections (B) above.
- 2. A student's absence which could not be accounted for by evidence of a legitimate or valid excuse in accordance with *Student Policy 5202* and Utah Admin R277-419.

D. Tardiness:

- 1. Failure of a student to be in their assigned seat/class on time is considered tardiness.
 - a. Tardiness can be excused with timely verification from the student's parent/guardian(s) in the event of an excusable absence.
 - b. Tardiness between classes for middle school students shall be marked by teachers;
 - c. Chronic tardiness between classes however may be escalated to a disciplinary issue; and

E. Truancy:

- 1. An absence on a student's record without a valid excuse is considered a truancy.
 - a. Athlos Academy will notify parent/guardian(s) by a phone call, text, or email within 24 hours of a student's unexcused absence so that a parent/guardian may call and excuse their child before he/she is marked absent for the day;
 - b. Five unexcused absences shall result in a *Compulsory Education Violation* or *Notice of Truancy* according to Student Policy 5202 and as outlined in Utah Code Section 53G-6-202 and Utah Code Section 53G-2-203.
