

Student Policy 5504 Approved: 10/18/2016 Revised: 2/21/2017

I. PURPOSE

This policy is necessary for establishing the certain instances in which Athlos Academy of Utah must notify parent/guardian(s) of incidents concerning their children.

II. POLICY

- A. Athlos Academy of Utah shall:
 - 1. Notify the parent/guardian(s) if their child threatens to commit suicide; or
 - 2. Notify the parent/guardian(s) of each student involved in an incident of bullying, cyber-bullying;
 - 3. Notify the parent/guardian(s) of a student who makes a false report of either of the above; and
 - 4. Produce and maintain a record that verifies that the parent/guardian(s) of the student involved in the incident(s) was notified; this record shall be maintained in accordance with *Student Policy* 5105 *Student Records Confidentiality* and all applicable state and federal law.
 - a. This record shall be maintained for as long as the student to whom it pertains is enrolled at Athlos Academy of Utah unless a request is made by the student to have the record expunged, if the student has graduated from High School or reached the age of majority.
 - b. A record created under this section shall only be destroyed in a secure manner that maintains the confidentiality of the record.
- B. Notification under the above section shall:
 - 1. Be made in a timely fashion once the safety of students and staff has been secured;
 - 2. Be made by the Lead School Administrator or designee;

3. Be made both via two forms of communication, including a phone call and one form of written communication; and

- 4. Maintain student confidentiality.
- C. Athlos Academy of Utah may not:

- 1. Disclose a record of an incident, including any information obtained to prepare the record, to a person other than a person authorized to receive the record; or
- 2. Use a record of an incident, including any information obtained to prepare the record, for the school's own purposes, as described in Utah Code § 53A-11a-203.
- D. A school may disclose a record of an incident, including any information obtained to prepare the record:
 - 1. To the parent/guardian or the parent/guardian's student; or
 - 2. To a person if required to disclose the record or information to a person pursuant to the terms of a court order as described in Utah Code § 63G-2-202(7)
- E. At the request of a parent/guardian, Athlos Academy of Utah may provide information and make recommendations related to an incident.
