

Homebound Student Education

Educational Programs Policy 6202 Approved: 8/16/2016 Revised: _____

I. PURPOSE

This policy establishes Athlos Academy of Utah's responsibilities for providing services to eligible homebound students.

II. POLICY

- A. Homebound student education services include the following:
 - 1. A minimum of 2 instructional contact hours per week;
 - 2. Documentation of that contact; and
 - 3. Justification of the services which may include specific injuries, surgery, illness, other disabilities, pregnancy, or a district determination that a student should receive home instruction and supervision for a designated period of time.
 - a. The expected period of absence must be estimated.
- B. Eligibility for homebound student education:
 - 1. The student is confined in a home or hospital setting due to physical illness, psychological or emotional illness, injury, disability or other short-term medical necessity.
 - 2. The student has missed, or expects to miss, 10 or more consecutive days of school.
 - 3. The student is consistently unable to attend school on a regular daily basis or is unable to attend at least 4 school periods per day because of a verified chronic illness or serious medical condition.
 - 4. Homebound education is generally considered to be short-term and must be requested by a parent/guardian.
 - 5. A written request for services is required from the attending physician.
 - a. The request must include the exam date, diagnosis, medication(s) that may limit or affect learning, expected duration of confinement, and any other pertinent information.
 - b. Athlos Academy, or a designated coordinator, will contact the physician for further verification and information as needed.

- c. Parent/guardian(s) must make a request to the attending physician that appropriate information pertaining to the student's medical condition be shared with Athlos Academy so that determination of eligibility for services can be made.
- 6. If the length of confinement is more than 6 weeks, a physician's update will be required in order to continue homebound services
- C. Homebound education conditions:
 - 1. Students who are placed on homebound shall remain enrolled Athlos Academy of Utah and shall not be counted as "absent."
 - 2. Athlos Academy of Utah shall assign a homebound instructor to the student.
 - a. The homebound instructor will coordinate the instructional schedule with the parent/guardian/teachers.
 - b. Instruction will be provided after regular school hours for a period of 2 hours per week.
 - c. The homebound instructor will coordinate teaching materials and assignments with the regular classroom teacher(s).
 - 3. Level of services:
 - a. If the student is homebound for a period between 1-10 days, the parent/guardian(s) will coordinate with the school administration for homework and assignments.
 - b. If the student is homebound for a period between 11-44 days, a homebound instructor will coordinate with parent/guardian(s), teachers, and school administration regarding the student's homework and assignments.
