

I. PURPOSE

Student Education Plans and Student Education/Occupation Plans provide direction for students in attaining an education or career immediately following high school. This policy outlines the process of implementation Athlos Academy of Utah will follow in order to remain compliant with state law.

II. DEFINITIONS

A. Student Education Plan/Student Education Occupation Plan (SEP/SEOP): Written plans updated annually and primarily developed through an ongoing collaborative partnership between individual students and their parent/guardian(s), in conjunction with the school counselor, or other school personnel, in order to identify student's skills and map out a strategy to guide a student's course selection.

III. POLICY

- A. The adopted Student Education Plan (SEP) shall be implemented in grades K-6 and will include opportunities to:
 - 1. Recognize a student's accomplishments and strengths; and
 - 2. Focus on educational goals and progress towards student achievement standards.
- B. The Student Education/Occupation Plan (SEOP) process shall begin at the start of 7th grade, involve the school counselor, and include the following elements:
 - 1. Identifies a student's skills and objectives;
 - 2. Plans and monitors career and/or education development goals and progress at least once a year;
 - 3. Maps out a strategy to guide student course selection; and
 - 4. Links a student to post-secondary options, whether they are educational or occupational in nature.
- C. Athlos Academy of Utah will report annually to stakeholders on the progress of the SEP/ SEOPs.
- D. Files of all SEP and/or SEOPs will be updated annually and kept as part of the student's cumulative file.
