School Athletic Activities Standards

I. PURPOSE

This policy delineates activity standards for coaches, Physical Education teachers, and athletic activities such as clinics or workshops associated with Athlos Academy of Utah.

II. POLICY

- A. Standards for Athletic Activities Personnel:
 - 1. All coaches and Physical Education teachers shall be appropriately certified.
 - 2. Coaches and other designated activities personnel shall diligently supervise their players at all times while working school-sponsored activities.
 - A coach or other designated activities personnel shall be an exemplary role model and shall not use alcoholic beverages, tobacco, or other controlled substances while working school-sponsored activities.
 - 4. Coaches, assistants and other activities personnel shall act in a manner consistent with Utah Code § 53A-11-908 and shall not use foul, abusive, or profane language while engaged in school related activities.
 - 5. All coaches and Physical Education teachers at Athlos Academy, in compliance with Utah Admin R277-613, shall participate in bullying and hazing prevention training.
 - a. They shall NOT permit hazing, demeaning, or assaultive behavior of any kind;
 - b. A refresher training course is required at least once every 3 years.

B. Standards for Athletic Activities:

- 1. School athletic personnel shall not require students to attend out-of-school camps, clinics, or workshops for which the personnel, activity leaders, coaches, or advisors receive payment from a source other than Athlos Academy.
- 2. Required or voluntary participation in summer or other off-season clinics, workshops, and leagues shall not be used as eligibility criteria for team membership, participation in extracurricular activities, or for the opportunity to participate in Athlos Academy of Utah programs.
