
I. PURPOSE

The purpose of this policy is to inform the school community and the general public of the position of Athlos Academy on visitors to school property.

II. POLICY

- A. Athlos Academy welcomes visits by parent/guardians and community members provided the visits are consistent with the health, education and safety of students and employees and are conducted within the procedures and requirements established by the school. All visitors must check in at the front office and obtain a visitor badge.
- B. An individual or group may be denied permission to visit Athlos Academy or such permission may be revoked if the visitor(s) does not comply with the school procedures and regulations, or if the visit is not in the best interest of students or school personnel.
- C. An individual or group who enters school property without complying with the procedures and requirements may be guilty of criminal trespass and thus subject to criminal penalty.
 - 1. Such persons may be detained by the Lead School Administrator or designee in a reasonable manner for a reasonable period of time pending the arrival of law enforcement.
- D. No individual wishing to visit or volunteer at the school shall be discriminated against on the basis of race, creed, color, national origin, religion, age, sex, sexual orientation, gender identity, pregnancy-related condition, veteran status, disability, or any other protected status under federal or state law.
